



**VARIETY:**

100% Merlot

**ORIGIN:**

Made with grapes from the Maule and Maipo valleys, with the Maule Valley giving us structure and the Maipo Valley adding red fruit notes and smoothness on the palate.

**CLIMATE:**

The 2011 season was characterized by below average temperatures, giving for more balanced wines with a lower alcohol content.

**HARVEST:**

Manual and machine harvesting.

**VINIFICATION:**

The process favored the extraction of fruity aromas and good quality tannins. Maximum temperatures of 28°C with no post-fermentation maceration.

**ANALYSIS:**

A°: 13.7 %  
TA: 4.63 g/L (C4H6O6)  
pH: 3.63  
RS: 1.6 g/L

**TASTING NOTES:**

*On the nose, the spice and fruity notes join together to give a lively wine with plenty of character. A deep wine, with great smoothness and a long finish.*

*Serving Suggestion: Ideal for accompanying pastas and pizzas, as well as Serrano ham and mature cheeses. Serve preferably at 17-19°C.*
