ORIGIN:

We have selected these valleys because their exceptional grapes, characterized by intense fruit aromas and ripe tannins. As a result we vinified a wine superbly harmonious. A medium body smooth Cabernet Sauvignon, complemented by subtle notes of oak.

CLIMATE:

The 2012 season was marked by over average temperatures at the end of the season. This event makes a much richer grape in terms of aroma and flavor.

Residual sugar: 7 g/L

COLOR:

Bright and intense red with purple hues.

AROMA:


Concentrate red fruit along hints of vanilla.

PALATE:

Rich flavors, ripe red fruit and spices.

MIGUEL'S NOTES:

This wine shows the real character of Cabernet Sauvignon. Intense nose with ripe red fruit, such as berries, along with hints of vanilla; on the palate displays a medium body, with extraordinarily smooth and delicate tannins. Enjoy every smooth and sultry sip. Ideal pairing: meats like steak and duck, as well as strong cheeses. Serve preferably at 62-64 °F (16-17°C)."
