90% CABERNET SAUVIGNON / 5% CARMÉNÈRE / 5% SYRAH
MAIPO, COLCHAGUA & MAULE VALLEYS - CHILE

ORIGIN:

The wine was made sourcing three different grapes from three of the best Chilean valleys, which delivers distinctive characteristics to our one of kind Red Blend, result of an excellent combination of ripe tannins and exceptional smooth character. For the Cabernet Sauvignon, we chose Maipo, Colchagua and Maule Valleys, while Carmenere and Syrah grapes were sourced exclusively from Maule Valley.

CLIMATE:

The 2012 season was marked by over average temperatures at the end of the season. This event makes a much richer grape in terms of aroma and flavor.

COLOR:

Vivid hues of black plum.

AROMA:

Intense ripeness and summer red fruits.

PALATE:

Ample flavors of savory cherry and dark cocoa with a long smooth finish.
