



SAUVIGNON BLANC 2013

100% SAUVIGNON BLANC
LEYDA & CURICO VALLEYS - CHILE

ORIGIN:

Our Sauvignon Blanc blends grapes from the prestigious Curicó and Leyda Valleys, in order to produce a well-balanced and intense wine. Curicó lend notes of tropical fruits such as passion along with citrus notes of grapefruit, while Leyda deliver complexity and aromatic freshness. During each step of the winemaking process, we have preserved the aromatic potential of the grapes in order to produce a more complex Sauvignon Blanc. The wine was briefly aged on its fine lees.

CLIMATE:

The 2013 vintage was cooler than normal, allowing the grapes to ripen slowly, with excellent natural acidity and aromatic freshness.

Residual sugar: 2.5 g/L

COLOR:

Pale yellow with subtle green hues.

AROMA:

Fresh and ripe citrus and tropical fruit.

PALATE:

Delicate, well balanced with a nice acidity.

MIGUEL'S NOTES:

"A glassful of intense and exuberant fruit; fresh tropical notes of passion fruit and citrus hints of grapefruit. On the palate displays fascinating fruitiness and a fresh acidity. Very more-ish. Serve preferably at 50-53 °F (10-12°C). Ideal for accompanying shellfish and salads or for enjoying on its own."
