December, 2009.- **Viña San Pedro** is pleased to let you know about a new and important acknowledgement bestowed to our wine's quality.

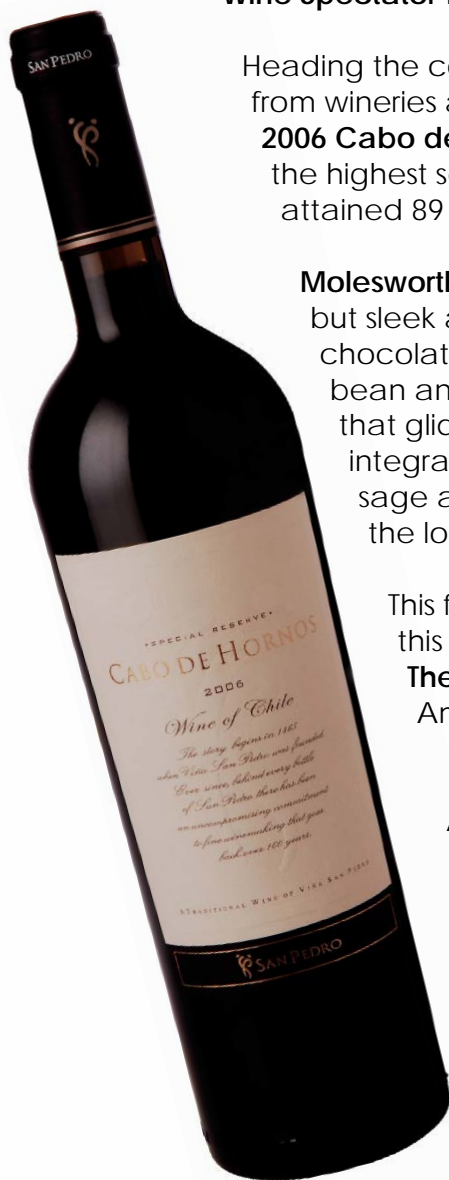
The new vintage of our Icon wine, **2006 Cabo de Hornos**, has just been rated with **91 points** by **James Molesworth**, wine-writer of the prestigious American magazine, **Wine Spectator** for its 31st December issue.

Heading the column about the new releases from wineries around the world, our **2006 Cabo de Hornos** appears with the highest score (the next one attained 89 points).

Molesworth described it as "Dark, but sleek and polished, with chocolate-covered espresso bean and warm fig sauce notes that glide over a loamy but well-integrated undertow. Roasted sage and tobacco chime in on the long finish."

This follows the same path as the **91+ points** awarded earlier to this wine, at the Chilean wine ranking published in April by **The Wine Advocate**, the magazine belonging to the famous American wine-critic, **Robert Parker**.

A wide ranking acknowledgement granted to the oenological work, the dedication to terroirs and the excellent quality of **San Pedro** wines.
